- For those "social visit pass" (tourist visa). Must submit their "**White Immigration Card**" together with their passport.
- Permanent Residents - Passport with PR endorsement stamp inside.
- International Passport to be use only.

2. MAG CARD/ BOARDING PASS

- Mag Card is used as a charge card, a key card and a boarding pass.
- Please keep your Mag card Safely. You will need to use the card upon embarking and disembarking at ports and also present it to collect your passport on arrival at your final destination.
- Please remember to bring along your Mag card for all meals.

3. BOARDING

- Before boarding, you will be required to show your passport & Mag card. The passport will be retained for checking and verification.

BOOKINGS POLICY

VISA/ PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS & PASSAGE RESTRICTIONS

1. All passports must have at least 6 months' validity from the date of sailing.
2. Any child whose travel document is attached to the parent's passport must travel with the accompanying parent.
3. Passengers are responsible to ensure all travel documents and visas are in order prior to departure from their home country. Visa and immigrations regulations vary depending on travel destinations and the nationalities of the passengers. Passengers are advised to consult their diplomatic representations on the immigration formalities for their proposed itineraries.
4. Passenger for pregnant woman will only be permitted before her 24th week of pregnancy at the time of sailing.
5. Star Cruises reserves the right to refuse embarkation to any passenger whose medical condition is not made known during reservation or prior to sailing, and shall not be required to refund any portion of the fare paid by the aforementioned passenger.
6. No refund will be made to passengers who are denied embarkation for non-compliance of immigration requirements.
